Maintaining Your Windmill

Friday 15th October 2010

TOPICS TO BE COVERED WILL INCLUDE:-

This course provides delegates with practical guidance on maintaining and running a windmill. Beginning with an appreciation of the heritage of windmills in this country The programme covers maintenance schedules, the planning of maintenance activities, creating a mill log to record works carried out at the mill and liaison with relevant authorities including the Listings authorities

- To gain an historical context for the construction and evolution of your windmill
- To develop a maintenance schedule for your mill covering weekly, monthly and yearly maintenance schedules
- To obtain practical guidance on how to run a working party, maintenance tasks including, paints and materials, maintaining bearings and effective cleaning of the mill. Health & Safety, Risk Assessment etc.
- To understand how to record activities

undertaken at the mill, capturing historical information and leaving full records for future generations of your actions

- To develop an appreciation of the SPAB Mills Section's philosophy on conservation, restoration and repair to ensure that the historic fabric of your mill is protected whilst allowing you to achieve your aims and objectives for the building

- To help you develop constructive working relationships with all relevant stakeholders who have an interest in your mill including English Heritage, Council Listings Authorities

- Volunteers or persons employed to work in windmills
- Conservation Officers

DIRECTIONS

There is ample parking at the NFU Mutual offices, but for those travelling by train the venue is about 2 ½ miles from Stratford Station. If travelling by bus from the Station, the bus stop is in nearby Wood Street. Bus numbers 15 and 18 start from here and leave at 10 or 30 minutes past each hour. It is only a 9 minute journey to Carters Lane, Tiddington which is opposite New Street. The buses return to Stratford from here about every ½ hour. It might be advisable to check with the bus company (www.stagecoachbus.com or 01604 676060) before travelling. Alternatively there is a taxi rank at the Station run by Grafton Taxis (0800 716240)
