Friday 1 June, evening

Georgian house in Clifton

Join us for an evening at a beautiful historic house in Hotwells, Clifton.

SPAB chairman Iain Boyd has invited us to his new old home for a informal gathering to open the weekend.

Nestled in one of the oldest squares in Bristol, the house is listed Grade II* and has a varied and fascinating history. We will have a chance to explore this private house and the plans for its repair. The evening will include a drinks reception.

Saturday 2 June

Walking tour of the historic city centre

Andrew Foyle, local historian and author of the Pevsner guide to Bristol, will give us the perfect introduction to the city in the morning. We will take in the medieval walls, historic markets, churches, bridges and buildings in the city centre.

Bristol Old Vic Theatre

The Old Vic is the UK's oldest continuously-running theatre. This year it is undergoing redevelopment to its front of house and studio theatre, following works to refurbish the Georgian auditorium in 2012. We will enjoy a private tour around the site by the architect before it opens to the general public later this summer.

St Thomas the Martyr: members' tea & meeting

All members are welcome for our annual get-together in an imposing Georgian church, now in the care of the Churches Conservation Trust. After tea and cake, the meeting will include a keynote speaker, updates from the SPAB director and chairman, and a presentation of the SPAB Betjeman award for works to conserve places of worship.

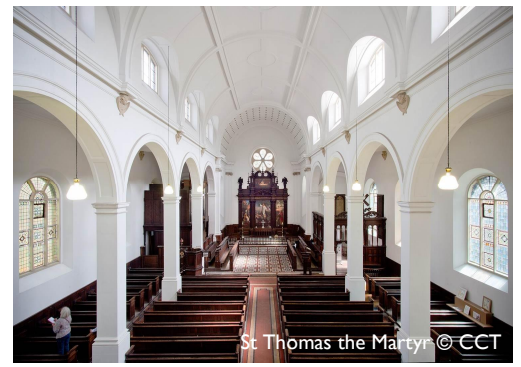
